Curriculum

MATH: Identifying the partners of 10.

READING: We are comparing characters in texts. Last week we explored Laura Numeroff books and this week we will compare Cinderella to her stepsisters. In letterland, we are continuing our unit on word families, rhyming words, and similarly spelled words. We are on short o words (-ot, -op, -ock).

WRITING: We will spend one more week on narrative writing. Then we will move onto opinion writing to finish out the year.

Science: We are still learning about living things. We will identify the characteristics of living vs. nonliving things. We will discuss the basic needs, growth, structure, changes, and movement of living things. We will also focus on animals that lay eggs life cycles, and plants.
