Curriculum

MATH: We will work on addition and subtraction fluency within 5. Then we will begin to learn partners of 10.

<u>READING</u>: We are identifying characters, setting, main events in fiction texts as well as comparing characters. In letterland, we are continuing our unit on word families, rhyming words, and similarly spelled words (ex: can, pan, man, tan).

WRITING: Narrative writing. Kids will be writing a true story that expands several pages about something that they did or something that happened to them.

Science: We still learning about living things. We will identify the characteristics of living vs. nonliving things. We will discuss the basic needs, growth, structure, changes, and movement of living things. This week we will focus on animals that lay eggs and life cycles.
