Curriculum

<u>MATH</u>: We are still focusing on the partners of numbers 2 through 6. This week we will begin solving addition story problems (word problems). The following week we will begin subtraction story problems.

READING: Sight words continue to be a big focus. We are also reading nonfiction books focusing on main idea and details and the relationship between the pictures and the text. We will be discussing nonfiction text features like the table of contents, glossary, index, captions, bold words, diagrams, and etc.

WRITING: We are still writing "all about" or informational text for the next 3 weeks. This week we will be writing about cats and dogs.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We are talking about how people and things change over time. We will be making timelines of the children's lives from birth to present. Then we will discus culture and how individuals are similar and different.
