#### Curriculum

MATH: Rote counting to 20. Writing the numbers 0—10. Counting groups of objects to 10 in order to tell how many. READING: Print concepts and reading behaviors (parts of a book, the reading direction, tracking print, the difference between a letter, a word, and a sentence. In Letterland, we will start our "FastTrack" this week. Students will get a brief introduction to 2 Letterlanders each day. We will be going over the sounds, actions, and letter names.

<u>WRITING</u>: We are writing (drawing with labels) friend books. The students conduct an interview of one of our new friends each day to get to know him/her better and then we draw about them. We will also be working on writing our names correctly.

SOCIAL STUDIES: We will be learning about SPO and the school—wide behavior expectations
