#### Curriculum

MATH: We will continue with subtraction story problems within the number 5.

<u>**READING**</u>: We are identifying characters, setting, main events in fiction texts as well as comparing different versions of the same story. We are identifying which sound is different in similarly sounding words (cat and cap). In letterland, we are beginning our unit on word families and rhyming words.

<u>WRITING</u>: We are starting narrative writing. We will be writing a story about something we have experienced together as a class this year in Kindergarten.

<u>Science</u>: We will begin our unit on living things. We will identify the characteristics of living vs. nonliving things. We will discuss the basic needs, growth, structure, changes, and movement of living things
